IV DECALS

SAFETY GUIDELINES

- 1.** Decals will be placed on the back of the IV bag, such that there is no obstruction of patient identification labels, drug information, or barcodes. Bags may be hung with the decorative decal facing outward, as long as the nurse can easily view the pharmacy labels on the reverse side.

 - 2.** Decals will be positioned such that there is a 1-inch gap between the bottom of the IV bag and the bottom of the decal. This will allow for visualization of any precipitate.

 - 3.** Decals will be placed on the IV bag by the patient's nurse, who will wear the appropriate PPE (standard or chemotherapy gloves, depending on the medication being infused).

 - 4.** Once applied, decals may not be removed from the IV bag and taken home by the patient, as they may be contaminated with trace amounts of chemotherapy. Decals may not be used on syringes and injectables.
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
